The Applications will be evaluated based on the merit or uniqueness of the following parameters:

3	<b>Secondary Engineering Controls:</b> a. Earthing Systems. b. Availability and usage of breakers ACB, VCB, ELCB / RCCB / MCCB / Relays / Variable Frequency Drives (VFD's) etc. c. Other secondary controls.	3	1000 words
4	<b>Energy Isolation, Lockout Tagout and Try out (LOTOTO)</b>	3	1000 words
5	<b>Administrative Controls :</b> a. Availability of competent resources. b. SOP for operations & maintenance. c. Inspection programs. d. Caution & Warning signages. e.
