- Large organisations can apply at Plant/SBU/Unit Level
- Companies/ Firms from the SME Category

### **Large Enterprise**

Revenue: > INR 250 crores

Investment: Above INR 20 crores

### SME\*

Revenue: < INR 250 crores

Investment: Less than INR 20 crores

\*Enterprises engaged in the manufacture or production, processing or preservation of goods. Investment in plant and machinery is the original cost excluding land and building and the items specified by the Ministry of Small-Scale Industries vide its Notification No.S.O.1722(E) dated October 5, 2006.

#Proof of the investment figure (a certificate by the auditors) is to be shared at time of Registration. In case of a CII Member, company's membership certificate would suffice.

- For Consolidated Category, applications > benchmark score of 75% for Large Enterprises and > benchmark score of 70% for SMEs, subject to Jury discretion
- For Domain Excellence(s), TOP 3 applications from Large Enterprise [>75% benchmarking score] AND SMEs [>70% benchmarking score] for each domain, subject to Jury discretion
